This is to advise you of a Davis-Bacon wage survey to be conducted within your jurisdiction. The Davis-Bacon and related Acts require the payment of locally prevailing wage rates and fringe benefits to employees of contractors and subcontractors performing work on federally financed or assisted construction projects. The Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Department of Labor is responsible for conducting wage surveys to establish the wage rates applicable to such construction projects.

This office will be collecting wage payment information on any Residential construction project(s) which were active and ongoing between 04/01/2016 and 03/31/2017 in the state of Pennsylvania for the counties on the attached list. This includes federal as well as non-federal projects. The wages being paid construction workers in this area may affect prevailing wage determinations issued as a result of this survey.

Survey WD-10 Forms have been included with this letter and additional forms may be obtained upon request. Data must be postmarked or submitted electronically by 11/30/2017 to be included in this survey.
